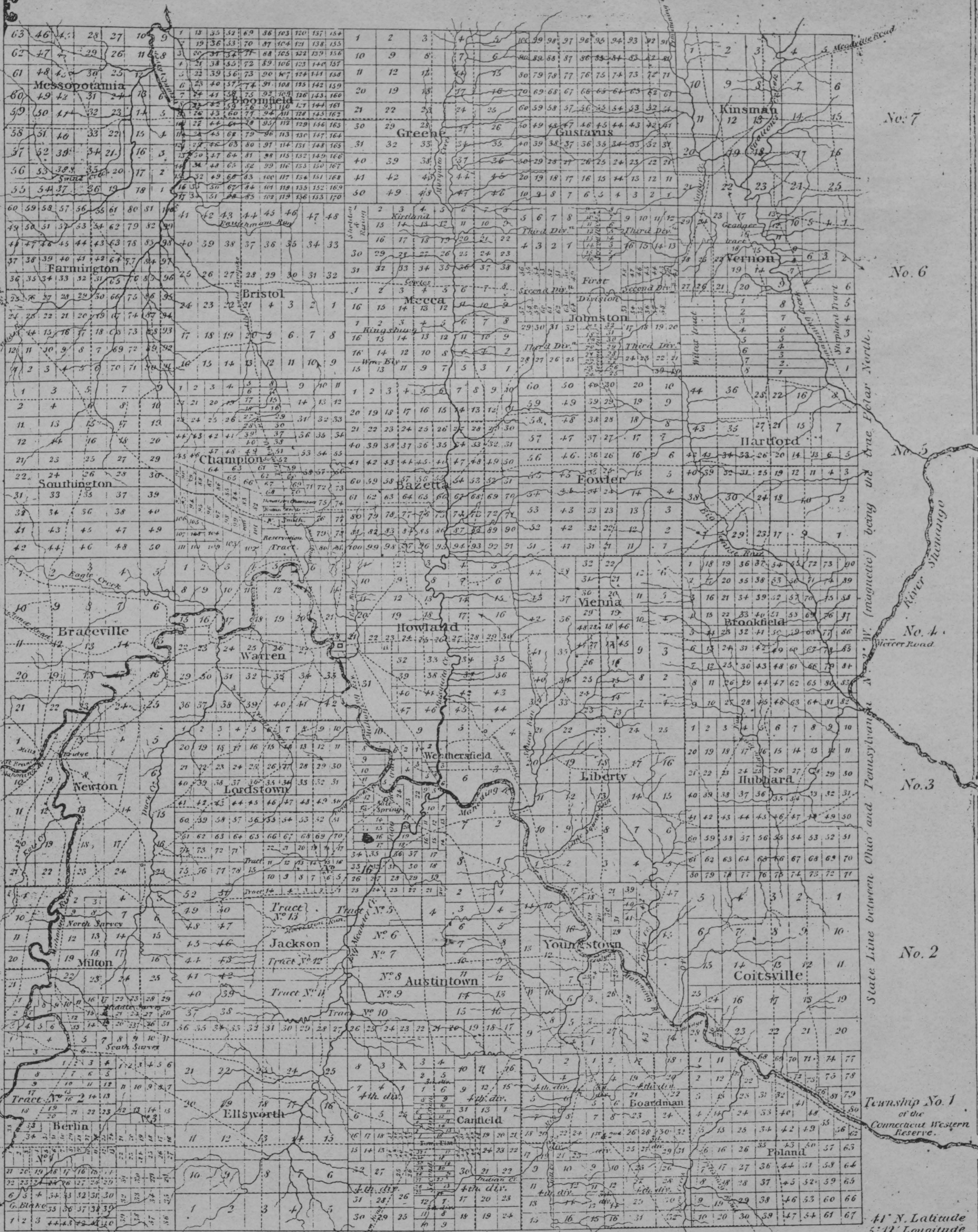

Remarks. The great salt spring, 24000 Acre tract, comprising part of Lordstown, Weathersfield, Jackson & Austintown, is surveyed into thirteen tracts, of different sizes and forms, numbered from No 4 to No 16 inclusive, besides the 4000 acre salt spring reservation, lying round the Salt Spring. Tract No 16 of the 24,000 acre tract is subdivided and allotted into lots with two series of numbers; one series No 1 to No 22 inclusive lies part in Lordstown, and part in Jackson; and the other series No 1 to No 37 inclusive lies part in Weathersfield, and part in Austintown, besides a gore of said tract No 16 about 7/8 of a mile wide along the west side of the 4000 acre tract. The 4000 acre salt spring reservation tract is subdivided & allotted into lots, numbered from No 1 to No 24 inclusive. The Township of Mecca, is surveyed into 4 separate tracts, with as many different series of numbers, denominated the Hartford tract - the Cortes tract, - and the Kingsbury tract, - and the Ely tract. Johnson, Vernon, Milton, Berlin, Canfield & Boardman, are also, allotted into tracts or divisions with different series of numbers for the subdivisions, as appears on the Map. The County Seat is in Warren on the East side of the Mahoning Riv. The Mahoning and Shenango at the junction in Pennsylvania form the big Beaver River. The Grand River waters empty into Lake Erie at Fairport.
